


Parish of Corpus Christi, Bolton

Twenty-Seventh Week of Ordinary Time



Today we tackle the issue of marriage and divorce; Jesus is asked an awkward question about the legality of divorce. He lays down very clearly that what God intends for marriage is what is found in Genesis (where the “two become one” for all time) rather

than the dispensation granted through Moses (permitting a writ of divorce) which was an exception, not the rule. Here it is clear that Jesus abrogates this Old Testament procedure - a point emphasised when the disciples press him further on this issue on getting back home. While it is important for us to be sensitive and understanding towards those whose marriages have gone awry, we must be careful to let the teachings of the Lord speak for themselves.

Marriage Matters

Two in one flesh - God said: *“It is not good that the man should be alone.”* Do I value my husband, my wife? Do I really know you, my beloved and lifelong companion? When was the last time we were intimate or celebrated our sexuality; the essence of our being two in one flesh? How much of a priority are you in my life?

Think Vocation

During this month of the Holy Rosary, let us continue to model our lives on the faith of Our Blessed Lady. We can resolve to pray the Rosary more regularly during this month and throughout the year. Perhaps we can dedicate our Rosary, at least once a week for vocations to the priesthood and Consecrated Life.

Hope in the Future

As part of the Hope In the Future programme a number of formation days were held throughout 2018. The aim of the days was to provide an opportunity to meet together and reflect on what it is to be missionary and what we mean by discipleship.

The sessions were led by Fr Gerard Kelly and focused on providing a time of reflection where we can consider the part that the Holy Spirit plays in all that we are doing. Evangelisation must touch our hearts, becoming the engine that drives us forward in our mission, it is the Holy Spirit who gives us the courage to advance.

On the last of the planned formation days, the Hope In the Future programme arranged for the talks to be filmed in four slots of thirty minutes. These have now uploaded onto the diocesan youtube channel and DVDs are being produced for each parish. Ideally, we hope that we will be able to arrange for the recordings to be shown here in Corpus Christi to provide some time for a reflection as a parish community.
